Sheba Fund
(Anonymous donor)
\$3,576,968
Established by a supporter of the foundation who prefers to remain anonymous. One half of the earnings is designated for projects that improve the lives of the elderly in extended and intermediate residential care, as well as home care. The remainder is split between supporting acute care patients and "the care and comforting of animals" (animal welfare). The foundation works with 'Friends of Nelson Elders' to disburse a portion of the fund's earnings.

BC Festival of the Arts Legacy
\$65,487
Fund created by the City of Nelson using proceeds of the BC Festival of the Arts held here in 2000. The income provides an annual grant for young or emerging artists. Granting focus changes each year, rotating among media arts, music, dance, theatre arts, literary arts and visual arts. Matching funds were contributed by the Vancouver Foundation and the Columbia Basin Trust.

Many donors or local charities have established endowment funds within the community foundation. Earnings from these funds flow back to designated organizations or causes.
